How to make a complaint

In person

If you wish to make a complaint about the National Memorial Arboretum whilst you are onsite, then please speak to a member of our team. We will do our best to resolve this quickly to enable you to enjoy the rest of your visit.

If a member of the team requires support to resolve your complaint, they will escalate this to their line manager or the Duty Manager.

Should we be unable to resolve the complaint immediately then we will take your contact details and agree next steps, including a date for us to contact you.
